

KAURI HEALTHCARE Privacy Statement

Kauri Healthcare is committed to protecting the privacy and wellbeing of patients and whānau. We recognise the importance of protecting personal and health information and manage this with the utmost care and respect.

We collect, use, store and disclose health information in accordance with the Health Information Privacy Code 2020, with Information Privacy Principle (IPP) 3A (indirect collection of personal information), and relevant New Zealand privacy legislation.

We collect and disclose information to support the provision of safe, high-quality healthcare, the effective management of our services, and to meet our legal and professional obligations.

Your health information will only be shared with authorised health professionals and organisations directly involved in your care, or if authorised by law.

Your health information is also collected from other agencies involved in your healthcare when it is shared with us. This is to support your ongoing care and treatment. These agencies include other health providers (including after-hours services such as City Doctors and Practice Plus), social services, education providers, whānau and caregivers, and government agencies. These agencies are required to let you know when they share that information with others. Examples of indirect collection include but are not limited to specialist reports, lab results, programme referrals, mental health and social services, medications, discharge summaries and clinic notes, screening programmes and immunisations.
